## 11–12 Supply List



- Crayola Crayons (24 or 48)
- Crayola Washable Markers (10 or 8 classic, bold or bright)
- 8 glue sticks
- 2–4 oz. bottle of white glue
- Watercolors (I suggest Prang or Crayola brand because they produce brighter and richer colors on paper)
- 1 Gallon of Juice and your child’s favorite snack (enough for 18 children)
- 1 box of resealable bags (large)
- 1 bag of paper lunch bags (any color)
- One ream each– white and colored printer paper

The above items will be used for the whole class and do not need to be labeled.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS SHOULD HAVE YOUR CHILD’S NAME ON THEM IN PERMANENT MARKER:

- Scissors– blunt end only (I suggest Fiskar or Crayola with a metal blade)
- **Plastic** Paint Smock
- Extra Change of clothes, including socks, underwear, pants, and top in a plastic bag and labeled with their name
- **1” plastic** nap mat, if your child stays for the afternoon (Please do not send large pillows or blankets since we are limited in our storage space. Children are allowed to bring a soft animal or doll for rest time and a small thin blanket is fine if it will help your child rest more comfortably).
- Backpack, especially if your child stays all day

**All of the above items can be brought to school during a scheduled open house or the first day of school.**
