



Admissions, Tuition, and Fees 2023-2024

Summit Christian School admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to the students of the School. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admission policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school administered programs.

Programs

PK3

Summit Christian School provides a preschool education to children who will be three years old by September 1st. This play-based course includes free play and the development of social skills as well as early literacy and numeracy skills. Half day PK3 students attend from 8:00-11:15am, Monday through Friday. Full day PK3 students also enjoy extra enrichment in the form of music or art specials and attend from 8:00-3:15, Monday through Friday. PK3 students must be potty trained and weaned off pacifiers. Supplies including a napper and mat will be required.

PK3 Registration Fee: A \$100 non-refundable registration fee per student is due before registration is complete.

VPK

Summit Christian School participates in the **Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK)** program that provides three hours of free pre-kindergarten daily for children who are four years old by September 1st. We will run two VPK classes, with a morning session running from 8:00 am - 11:15 am, and an afternoon session running from 12:00 pm - 3:15 pm. There are no fees or tuition due for the half day VPK program.

*Payment plans begin in July and end with the last payment in May. All payments are due the 1st of each month.

Field Trips: Classes at Summit Christian School participate in a variety of field trips related to the curriculum. The fees and number vary per grade level and are billed to parents.

A \$30.00 late payment fee will be assessed for tuition received after the 10th of the month. A \$30.00 fee will be assessed for returned checks/reversed debits, or insufficient funds.

All families are required to have a FACTS Tuition Management account where billing is processed for tuition and incidental expenses.

Tuition payments, if paid monthly, are due on the first day of each month. The tuition cycle runs for 11 months, from July 1st through May 1st.

Tuition Discounts and Financial Aid

Only one tuition discount or SCS financial aid award may be applied to a family's tuition balance (with the exception of the pre-payment discount).

Tuition Discounts

The following discounts may be applied to tuition balances **after** the application of state scholarships such as Step Up For Students (Florida Tax Credit scholarship; Unique Abilities, etc.).

- a. **Multiple Child** – This discount is applied from oldest to youngest student and can be applied toward pre-school tuition (excluding VPK Only students). There is a 6% discount for the second child, a 15% discount for the third child, and a 35% discount for the fourth and each additional child.
- b. **Westminster Presbyterian Church Member** – There is a 15% discount for children whose parents are members in good standing of Westminster Presbyterian Church.
- c. **Minister** – For children of ordained ministers of Bible-believing evangelical churches employed full-time in pastoral ministry, there is a 50% discount.
- d. **Pre-payment** – Prepayment discount applies to the annual tuition and must be received in full by July 1, 2023. Prepayment discount of 3% does not apply to other fees and is not available to families receiving financial assistance through Summit Christian School.

Financial Aid

Financial aid is determined after April 15th each year, since the process requires the previous year's tax information.

- a. **Need-Based Financial Aid** – Financial aid may be available based on need. Application may be made at <https://online.factsmtg.com/signin/3V16S>. Under normal circumstances, Summit does not offer more than a 50% scholarship for financial assistance.
- b. **Step Up For Students (Florida Tax Credit Scholarship- FTC)** – The Florida Tax Credit Scholarship provides scholarships for K-12th grade students in the state of Florida based on income. Families may visit www.stepupforstudents.org for more information.
- c. **Family Empowerment Scholarship Unique Abilities (FES-UA)** – The Family Empowerment Scholarship (Unique Abilities) are available through Step Up for Students for students with specific learning disabilities and clinically-diagnosed medical conditions.

Financial Obligations

Accounts must be current for a student to attend classes, receive a report card, and have records released. Once an account becomes 30 days delinquent, the student is subject to dismissal. Upon withdrawal or dismissal, the student's records (except medical) will be held until all financial obligations are paid. No deductions or refunds of tuition will be made for withdrawal, absence, or dismissal. In cases where a student is enrolled during the school year, tuition is prorated on a quarterly basis.

Payment Commitment to Summit Christian School

Summit Christian School is dependent upon the regular tuition payments of parents, the support of Westminster Presbyterian Church, and benefactors who are committed to Christian Education.

By signing this financial agreement and enrolling your child, you are committing to the payment of tuition and fees required.
